OVERVIEW

FHI 360's comprehensive approach to the response to HIV and AIDS is driven by innovative clinical research combined with a long track record of direct engagement at national, regional, facility and community levels to expand access to and strengthen the quality of prevention, care and treatment services. Globally our work touches all stages of the continuum, including counseling and testing, prevention of mother-to-child transmission, male circumcision, initiation and retention in clinical and community care, adult and pediatric ART initiation and adherence, and TB/HIV co-infection, supported by strengthened laboratory and pharmaceutical systems.

In prevention, we bring particular expertise in programming for adolescent girls, as well as other vulnerable populations, including sex workers, men who have sex with men, transgender persons, people who inject drugs, truck drivers, and communities located along transport corridors.

HIV CARE AND TREATMENT

In care and treatment, we support governments in increasing access to and improving the quality of services, training and mentoring clinical staff, strengthening clinical-community linkages, analyzing and using data, revising policies and guidelines, strengthening overall planning and management, and mainstreaming HIV into the broader public health system.

Funded by PEPFAR through USAID, the Care and Support for Improved Patient Outcomes (CaSIPO) project supports the South African Government in strengthening referral systems and improving retention and adherence through the integration of comprehensive care and support within the public health system.

HIV AND TUBERCULOSIS

Across the region, FHI 360 has strengthened efforts by governments to respond to tuberculosis (TB). Our experience in TB includes early case detection, diagnosis and treatment; strengthening of laboratory capacity; management of drug-resistant TB; management of TB/HIV co-infection; and health systems strengthening.

Supported by the Lilly MDR-TB Partnership via United Way Worldwide (UWW), Strengthening the Response to Drug-Resistant Tuberculosis in the Public Health Sector (2014-2017) project provides support the National Department of Health (NDOH) and its partners in decentralizing the MDR TB response and achieving the DR-TB targets in the National Strategic Plan.

NUTRITION

FHI 360 supports the development and implementation of national nutrition policies, strategies, programs, and systems that result in sustainable nutrition service delivery at both the health facility and community levels.

Funded by PEPFAR through USAID, the Nutrition Assessment, Counseling and Support Component of the Capacity Development and Support program strengthens the capacity of South African Government and PEPFAR implementing partners to deliver a comprehensive set of nutrition interventions to improve the nutritional status of vulnerable individuals.

CAPACITY STRENGTHENING

FHI 360 strengthens the technical and institutional capacity of NGOs, CBOs, and networks, helping them to achieve measurable and sustainable results while adapting strategically to evolving conditions and responding to new opportunities. Our approach combines training, mentoring, and tailored technical assistance across key areas of organizational development and technical expertise.

Funded by PEPFAR through USAID, the Capacity Development and Support (CDS) project provides technical and organizational capacity development support to South African Government (SAG) and civil society partners with the goal of strengthening the response to HIV and AIDS.

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
