WHO WE ARE

OPTIONS is one of five microbicide projects funded by USAID, in partnership with PEPFAR, working to accelerate and sustain access to antiretroviral-based HIV prevention products, also known as PrEP.

WHAT WE DO

OPTIONS works to help countries move from PrEP potential to PrEP impact, so adolescent girls and young women have HIV prevention options that meet their needs.

HOW WE DO IT

COUNTRY LEVEL:

Support a Strategic Approach to PrEP Scale-Up in Kenya, South Africa, and Zimbabwe

- Produce analyses and tools for technical working groups and MOH to inform and facilitate a strategic, systems approach to PrEP scale-up
- Identify and fill gaps in PrEP planning and implementation through operations research and stakeholder consultations

REGIONAL LEVEL:

Develop Evidenced-Based Tools & Capacity

- Develop tools to capture effective processes from OPTIONS countries and support PrEP scale-up in non-OPTIONS countries
- Facilitate PrEP learning collaboratives for policymakers, funders, and implementers
- Publish new research, analyses and case studies on PrEPWatch.org

GLOBAL LEVEL:

Coordinate Global Action to Support PrEP Scale-Up

- Facilitate regular calls for microbicide-related global stakeholders to foster collaboration and avoid duplication across initiatives and organizations
- Bring together global stakeholders to discuss key implementation challenges via satellite sessions and conference programs
- Partner with the International Partnership for Microbicides (IPM) to support global and national launch of the dapivirine ring




