Being an entrepreneur means you start your own business and earn money from the product or service your company provides.

People who start their own business often have certain personality traits, skills, and characteristics that help them solve problems, work with people, and do excellent work.

Instructions

- 1 Identify at least two personality traits, skills, or characteristics of an entrepreneur to include in your comic strip.
- 2 Create your comic strip's basic storyline about starting a business.
- 3 Identify two main characters.
- 4 Write the dialogue that will tell your story.
- 5 Put it all together in your comic strip.

Planning your comic strip

1. Write at least two personality traits, skills, or characteristics of an entrepreneur that you'll include in your comic strip.

2. What will happen in your comic strip? What is the basic action or story?
 - Your comic strip's characters or story should include or refer to someone who is providing money or other resources to help the entrepreneur start the business.



3. Who is in your story? Create two main characters.

4. Review the comic strip template on the last page of the worksheet and plan what each character will say in each frame.


Drawing your comic strip

Length: Use four frames to tell your story.


Images: Draw what is happening in each frame.

Dialogue: Use bubbles like these to capture what your characters say or think.




