## The PACED decision-making model: Example scenario

Step	Description	Example
<b>P</b> roblem	Identify the problem to be solved or decision to be made.	You're hungry, and you're driving from school to work.
<b>A</b> lternatives	Consider the options you have for solving the problem.	
<b>C</b> riteria	Decide what features or qualities you'll use to compare the different options.	
<b>E</b> valuate	Analyze the options based on your criteria.	
Decide	Make a decision based on the results of your evaluation.
