An expository paragraph: My personal savings statement

The role of an expository paragraph is to explain, inform, describe, or provide information. Working in the language you're studying, write an expository paragraph that describes your core values around saving. Core values are underlying principles that help us prioritize how we spend our time and money – in other words, how we decide which things are more important than other things. Organize your paragraph into three parts: a topic sentence, supporting sentences, and a concluding sentence.

A topic sentence:	
Presents your topic or main idea. In this case, what are your core values around saving money?	



Section	Writing
Supporting sentences:	
 Provide evidence or examples to reinforce the topic sentence. 	
 Organize ideas in a logical sequence. 	
 May illustrate a point, justify a claim, or contrast ideas. 	
A concluding sentence:	
 Brings closure to your paragraph. 	
 May summarize key points or revisit ideas from the topic sentence. 	
 May use words to indicate conclusions are being made (e.g., therefore or thus).
